The sheep

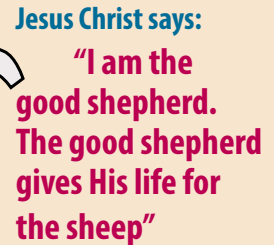
- > Sheep need somebody who guides and leads them.
