The rain poured down onto the roof. Outside, the water rose higher and higher. It didn't stop raining. It took forty days and forty nights.

And what about the Ark? The Ark began to float. The water even covered the highest mountains. You couldn't see anything of the cities and forests anymore.

Everything had drowned in the waters, even the people. Then God thought: "It is enough." And it stopped raining. After many weeks, the earth dried again. Noah and his family and the animals could finally leave the Ark. They were happy and thanked God for having been rescued by the Ark.

God said to Noah: "Do you see the rainbow in the sky? Each time when you see the bow it will remind you that I love the people and that I want to save them."

You can read this story in the Bible. It is written at the very beginning of the Bible, in Genesis chapters 6-9.




This is why God sent His Son, the Lord Jesus, into this world. **He died for you on a cross!** For your sins! – And now? Jesus Christ is alive! He has risen!



Finally she told her mum:
"Mummy, I can't find my puppy!
Maybe he got lost outside...
oh my poor puppy!" Her mum
soothed her: "I'm sure we'll find
your puppy. Now go to bed,
and tomorrow we will look for
him. Why don't you pray to God
for help?"

Some days passed, but Sue just couldn't find the puppy. She was very, very sad.

One day, while mum was cleaning Sue's room, she called, "Sue! Look what this is!" – Behind the bed Sue found a very dusty puppy. "Oh, my puppy," she said. "What are you doing here? I was so scared!" She reached out her hand, pulled the puppy out of the corner and tenderly

freed him from the dust. Sue and the other toy pets were so happy to have the puppy back.

Like Puppy was, all people are "dusty". Every time they do something bad, like lying or taking what is not theirs (God calls it sin), they load some more "dust" (=sins) on themselves. But the problem is: they can't cleanse themselves, like you dust a dusty shelf or like Sue cleaned her puppy. Only Jesus can do it, and He is sad about people being lost in sin. Say to Him: "Jesus, I'm so dusty with sin. I'm sorry that I have sinned, I want to become clean again." He will then take the "dust" away and give you a completely new life.

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
